## 2019 Point-In-Time Count

The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is an annual census of sheltered and unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness carried out locally on a single night in the last 10 days of January.

### Demographics

- 32% persons in households with children and adults
- 2% unaccompanied children
- 6% unaccompanied youth age 18-24
- 8% US Military Veterans
- 18% Chronically homeless

### Local Housing Programs for Formerly Homeless Persons Offer Paths to Stability

#### Rapid Re-Housing

- Approximately **1,700** people housed in **125** programs
- Short term support to get people with lower acuity into permanent housing

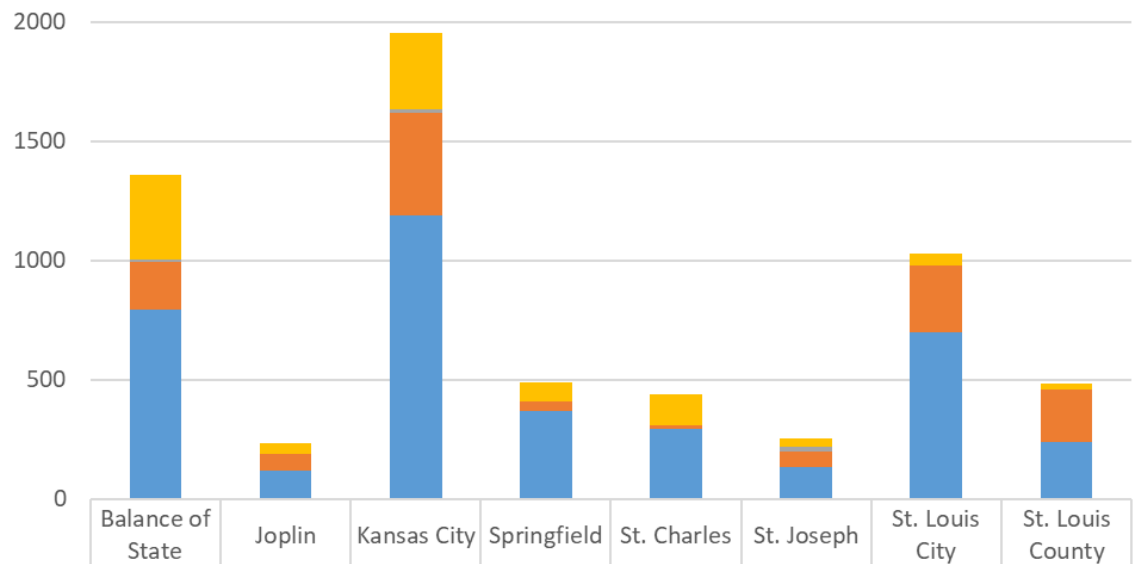
#### Permanent Supportive Housing

- Approximately **6,500** people housed in over **150** programs
- Gives people support they need while they take control of their lives
