The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is an annual census of sheltered and unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness carried out locally on a single night in the last 10 days of January.

# Local Housing Programs for Formerly Homeless Persons Offer Paths to Stability

### **Rapid Re-Housing**

- Approximately 1,700 people housed in 125 programs
- Short term support to get people with lower acuity into permanent housing

### **Permanent Supportive Housing**

- Approximately 6,500 people housed in over 150 programs
- Gives people support they need while they take control of their lives
